## Moffett 2017 Pinot Noir Terrarossa Vineyard, Dundee Hills

### WINEMAKER NOTES

Terrarossa is a quaint 2.58 acre volcanic soil vineyard that sits at roughly 800 feet elevation in the Dundee Hills. This backyard vineyard is farmed by Sterling Fox, one of the more respected Organic vineyard managers in the state. Terrarossa Vineyard has 3 different clones: Pommard, 777 and 115. This wine has quickly become a family favorite.

The 2017 Moffett Dundee Hills Pinot Noir: This vintage reminds of the 2015, my first full harvest in Oregon. This wine is so full of rich marionberry & dark cherry fruit with bright acidity on the edges, the finish is one to enjoy.

### 1-14-22 Tasting Notes / Observations:

The 2017 is showing little age at this time and has remarkable balance. The deep cork of fruit is still the main focus on this wine. I'm very impressed with this wine and look forward to seeing what it does in the next 3-5 years.

### PERFECT PAIRINGS

This wine pairs perfectly with grilled Salmon. I like putting a thin layer of Dijon Mustard on the top of the filet, then putting the Salmon on a medium to hot grill, skin down, and keeping the lid closed till ready. Simple and really good!
