## Moffett 2017 Pinot Noir Willamette Valley

### WINEMAKER NOTES

2017 was another great vintage in the Willamette Valley. The three sources for this vintage came from three different appellations; the first is the Eola-Amity Hills, where we get strictly Pommard fruit. The second is the Dundee Hills, which is a little higher elevation and has 777 and 115 clones. The final source in the Yamhill Carlton vineyard where Pommard and 667 are used is this blend. Having all these different components allows us to blend a wine with great complexity bring in the different nuances from each appellation.

### TASTING NOTES

The 2017 has beauty red fruit and spice aromas that really fill up the glass. On the palate the wine has lots of layers, but is an elegant style of Pinot Noir. The finish is long and dances on your palate.
