WINEMAKER NOTES

This is Moffett Vineyards inaugural release from the Bieze Vineyard.

The Bieze Vineyard is an impressive site in the Eola-Amity Hills. This 17 acre marine sediment vineyard, has a waiting list of wineries looking to get their hands on some of the fruit. Fortunately for me, my consulting winemaker Drew Voit was one of the first contracted winemakers to get fruit, so the Bieze's allowed me a small contract for a couple tons. Bieze Vineyard is continuous to Seven Springs Vineyard owned by Evening Lands, which have received a ton of press lately. Bieze will be next!

PERFECT PAIRINGS

Because this isn't released and won't be released for another two year, I haven't played with it yet. With that said, this wine will cut through any fatty dishes and proudly accompany a 2 inch thick Rib-eye.
