



Moffett 2018 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2018 Reserve Cabernet is a barrel blend from three different continuous vineyards that my father planted back in 1985 on our neighboring properties to our old Winery. These are all Rutherford Bench land properties producing the highest quality fruit. A touch of Petit Verdot was added to help list the aromas and lengthen the finish.

Tasting Notes:

Dark color, aromas of ripe black currant, black cherry and oak. Medium to full bodied with excellent concentration. The tannins are well hidden behind all the fruit, but still present with good acidity the holds the flavors on your palate for a nice long finish. Still young and will age really well. Peaking probably in 12-18 years, call me then and I will have a little in the library, for these bottles – Enjoy!

Perfect Pairing:

Let's stay with the classic Spring Grilling. Great with a steak, baby-back ribs or a nice Lamb chop.
