Moffett 2018 Pinot Noir Terrarossa Vineyard, Dundee Hills

WINEMAKER NOTES

Terrarossa is a quaint 2.58 acre volcanic soil vineyard that sits at roughly 800 feet elevation in the Dundee Hills. This backyard vineyard is farmed by Sterling Fox, one of the more respected Organic vineyard managers in the state. Terrarossa Vineyard has 3 different clones: Pommard, 777 and 115. This wine has quickly become a family favorite.

The 2018 Moffett Dundee Hills Pinot Noir brings a nice dark fruit aroma with overtones of toasted oak. On the palate the wine is full bodied black cherry and strawberry fruit, the tannin structure and acidity are well balanced and this wine should age really well over the next 8-10 years.

PERFECT PAIRINGS

Of all the Terrarossa Vineyards Dundee Hills wines I've produced, this is the one that I would pair with a nice juicy Rib-eye! Pair this up with your backyard BBQ and enjoy.
